Rules and Regulations - PLEASE READ

I hereby apply as an entrant in the 2011 America's Miss Pageant. I certify that I will be 13 and under 19 years of age for the Teen division, 19 and under 27 years of age for the Miss division, at least 21 years of age, unmarried (single, divorced, widowed) for the Ms. Division, or at least 21 years of age for the Mrs. Division on May 1, 2011. Teen and Miss contestants must be single, with no children and never haven given birth. Ms. and Mrs. contestants may be a parent. Mrs. contestants must also be married to a born male and must be residing with him. All applicants must either be a resident of the state in which she is applying for, own property, attend school or is employed in that state or region. Applicant must not hold a national title with any other pageant, as of April 1, 2011 and may not participate in any other pageants during the time I hold this state or regional title, without written approval from the America's Miss Organization's (AMO) national director. . She must be a U.S. citizen, in good health, not now pregnant and of good moral character. The applicant, parent and/or a legal guardian (if applicable) will be required to sign a contract agreement and submit an additional \$200 sponsor fee installment within 30 days of notification of acceptance. If she fails to do so, her title may be offered to another individual, with no refunds. Sponsor fee, deposits, as well as any monies submitted are non-refundable, non-transferable and there will be absolutely NO refunds given for any reason. Applicant and/or parent signing this form gives permission to America's Miss Organization (hence after AMO) and their licensees to use applicants photograph for publicity purposes in connection with the AMO without compensation to applicant or family. The director's and staff of the AMO, its subsidiaries, host hotel and location(s) where the event(s) are being held will not be held responsible for any damages, or liabilities due to accident, injury or loss of property resulting from applicant's participation in a state or the national pageant. The AMO reserves the right to change the location and/or date of the National Pageant should there be cause. AMO reserves the right to substitute another prize of equal value, if a specified prize becomes unavailable. Cash prizes and scholarships may be reduced if there are less than 80 participants in the National Pageant.
