All applicants must either be a six month resident of the state in which she is applying for, own property, attend school or is employed in same. The applicant, parent and/or a legal guardian (if applicable) will be required to sign a contract agreement and submit sponsor balance no later than May 15, 2010 to allow for ordering of state crown and banner. If she fails to do so, the title will be offered to another individual. Sponsor fee, application fee, as well as any monies submitted are non-refundable, non-transferable and there will be absolutely NO refunds given for any reason.
